USE OF PLAY APPARATUS

Please can I remind you that children are not allowed, under any circumstances, to use any of the outside play equipment - either before or after school.

PLEASE PARK AND STRIDE

Remember, if you 'park and stride' children benefit from a 5-10 minute walk, it also relieves traffic congestion and makes pedestrian access safer for our children.

Too many parents are parking illegally on the pavement immediately outside the school gates. This makes it difficult for cars to pass and dangerous for pedestrians.

We also experience problems with cars on school grounds during the day. If you are collecting your child from an after school activity you must always park outside the school grounds. Parents/Carers using Breakfast Club or After School Club are allowed to drive onto the school grounds. However, PLEASE do not park on the yellow box in front of the cycle shelter or anywhere along the driveway. Both of these areas MUST be kept clear at all times in case an emergency vehicle needs to access school grounds. The only other time cars are allowed on to school grounds during the day is to collect a child who is ill.
