

I appreciate that the new parking restrictions outside of school may make it difficult but we need to ensure the children are safe at all times. Parents using the before and after school facility may still bring their vehicles onto the car park to drop off or collect. If any parent has any access issues, including disabilities, then we will of course make accommodations for this.

Parking Restrictions. I am sure that parents will have seen the new parking restrictions outside of the school. The wording on the public notice order that I have seen states that the effect of the order is to prohibit waiting in parts of Woodthorne Road South, Yew Tree Lane and The Meadway. I wanted to draw this to your attention so that no parent is caught out by the new measures.
