Dates for your Diary

In Nursery we are learning:

- To initiate play offering cues to peers
- To become confident to talk to each other when playing
- To use one handed tools and equipment and hold a pencil between thumb and 2 fingers and use it with good control to write our names
- To listen to stories with increasing attention and recall
- To match numerals and quantities correctly and show awareness of shapes in the environment
- To comment and ask questions about aspects of our familiar world.

At home:

- Please share your child's book with them; you could talk about:
- What has happened in the book.
 - If it is a story book or an information book.
 - What has happened in the beginning, middle and end.
 - Whether you and your child liked the book or not and why?
