This half-term, we will be celebrating Woodthorne's 60th anniversary, it's a very special time as we are commemorating when Woodthorne opened.

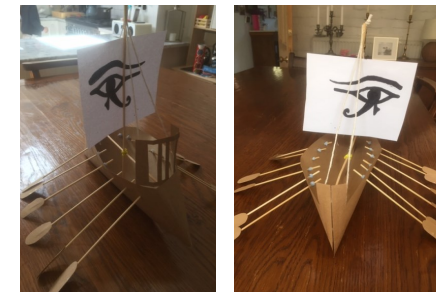
