There were lots of aircraft.</i></p> <p>2 - Can you make a list of all the things (nouns) you can see in the picture? Can you think of an adjective to describe each of the nouns in your list? Can you write descriptive sentences about the nouns in the list?</p> <p>3 – Experiment with sentence lengths. We know that just using one type of sentence length is pretty boring to read. Make a bank of short, medium and long sentences. Try to combine different lengths – which work best together?</p> <p>4 – Planning. Decide what will happen in each of your paragraphs.</p> <p>5 – Try putting it all together! Use this story starter: <i>The invasion had begun. Faced with row upon row of white-clad storm troopers, the Jedi knew they had to act quickly...</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">May the force be with you!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Air resistance – Luke Skywalker needs a parachute to escape the burning shuttle. Investigate how the surface area of the parachute affects the time it will take for Luke to land safely. We'd love to see your results. - Gravity – During the Clone Wars, clone troopers had to be equipped with magnetised boots to traverse environments with zero gravity. What would happen if we didn't have gravity? How would life be different? - Water resistance – Design a vessel for the Jedi to travel through water. The vessel must allow them to travel as quickly as possible. How will this impact your design? 	<p>Create your own planet for the Star Wars series.</p> <p>Think carefully about your planet's:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - size - surface – rock? Water? - atmosphere – which element can be found? Nitrogen? Carbon dioxide? Oxygen? - biology – what bacteria/plants/animals can be found on it? - visitors – can humans visit it? Are there aliens? <p>Could you also create your own creature for this planet? How is it able to survive?</p>
