

The school will :

- Support children's social and emotional needs as they return to the school environment.
- * Keep group sizes small .
- Make sure children wash their hands regularly and thoroughly.
- Arrange the learning environment and provide individual resources to reduce risk and promote social distancing.
- * Alter the school day and arrangements to promote social distancing and reduce risk.
- * Keep parents informed of changes to routines and arrangements.

However, it is not possible for:

- Teachers to be with all of their own class.
- Classes to be in their own classroom.
- Teach 'normal lessons'.
- Children to play with their friends.

Home School Agreement

To support phased re-opening of schools.

By working together, we can support everyone in finding a way forward and staying safe.

Parents must:

- Parents must keep their child off school if they or a family member is showing any symptoms—please follow latest government guidance.
- Respect the decisions made by school and understand that the safety and welfare of children and staff must come first.
- Arrive at the designated time to drop off and collect children in the designated places.
 Please ensure you are not late.
- Contact the office by telephone or email, not in person.
- Make sure children wear clean clothes everyday.
- * Tell children to walk straight home.
- Maintain social distancing AT ALL TIMES to minimise the risk to everyone.

It is not possible for:

- Parents to meet face-to-face with staff.
- Parents to go to the school office in person.
- Parents to wait on the playground.

The children must :

- Follow social distancing rules in school and on school grounds.
- * Stay in their seat unless told by their adult in years 1—6.
- Wash their hands before leaving the house/when they enter school and regularly throughout the day.
- Maintain social distancing on the playground.
- Remember to use a tissue when sneezing or coughing.
- Not bring any items into school, including bags/PE kits - coats only if necessary.
- Keep long hair tied back and no jewellery allowed.
- * Walk straight home.



Home School Agreement

To support phased re-opening of schools

By working together, we can support everyone in finding a way forward and staying safe.



- During this period of phased reopening, we will be reviewing all procedures constantly to ensure that we are doing our best to keep everyone safe and protected.
- We will continue to provide home learning grids for children who are not attending school.
- Parents will not be penalised for not sending children back to school but the advice is that children should be coming back.
- Nursery children must bring in a packed lunch in a plastic/paper bag which will be disposed of after lunch.
- Key Stage 1 and Reception children will have a packed lunch provided by the school kitchen as part of the Universal
 Free School Meals. Year 6 children receiving free school meals will also have a packed lunch from the school kitchen..
- Any Key Stage 2 children not on free school meals, who bring lunch from home, must use a plastic/paper bag which will be disposed of after lunch.
- Social distancing is vital and we will do our best to maintain it in school. Parents should ensure they are continuing to follow the most up-to-date guidance on social distancing out of school.
- If you do not feel that you or your children will be able to follow the expectations set out in this agreement, please let us know as this will increase the risk to other children and staff which must be avoided.
- If children are unable to be safe and keep others safe, parents will be contacted and may need to collect them from school.
