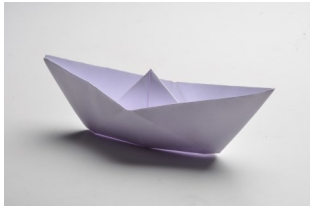
Away We Go!
