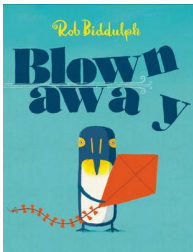
Away We Go!

What words rhyme with blown?

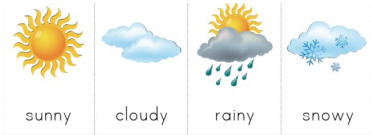


What other items or animals do you see in the sky? Can you write them down or draw pictures of them?
