Can you cut out triangles, rectangles, squares and circles to build an amazing space rocket?




Keep working on those scissor skills please.

### P.S.E.D.

Meet an Alien Adventure. What positive things could you tell the alien about you? How could we make friends?

If you were going to space, what would you take? Can children draw a picture of their bag and what they'd put in it?



You can add photos and feelings words in your scrap book.

### Maths

Can you make 2D shape aliens or 2D shape rockets? Cut shapes out of paper and stick them to make interesting shapes and creations. Can you remember the names of all the shapes?



Using ordinal language (first, second, third, etc) can children name the planets in order? What is the first planet from the sun?

Which position is the Earth from the sun?

### Literacy & Phonics

Space is full of interesting things. Can you make a fact file writing about all the different objects in space such as Mars is red, Venus is hot, Jupiter is the biggest planet, The Sun is a star?

Can you draw and label a new alien friend? What would they look like? Can you use your phonics to make your alien say strange, alien words?

Imagine you've gone to a strange, alien planet. Can you draw the planet, label it and write about what happens there? What will you discover? Who will you meet? Is it scary or fun? Tell us the story!



Remember to use your phonic knowledge as you write. Listening carefully for all the sounds in the words you are trying to write. Which tricky words can you remember and recognise?

### Design & Make

We really loved your aquariums in sea week, so this week, do you think you could make a space-scene? What would you see in space or on a planet? Would the trees look like they do on Earth? Would you see a rocket there or aliens? What colours would you see? Can you mix the colours to see what happens?



Can you fold and design an amazing space plane? Make more than one, you could see how far they fly? Which space plane went the furthest?
