Anabelle has been busy going on lots of walks, baking cookies and looking after the plants in her garden. Well done Anabelle!

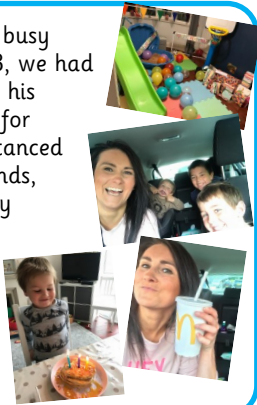
Simran has learnt to ride her bike without stabilisers! Well done Simran!

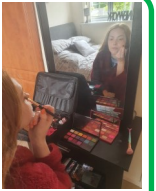

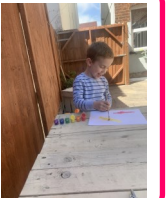
If there is anything at all you need, please get in touch and we will do everything we can to help and support you.
