Tallulah has used her imagination to design a red bus and a map for the bus to follow as it goes on its journey.

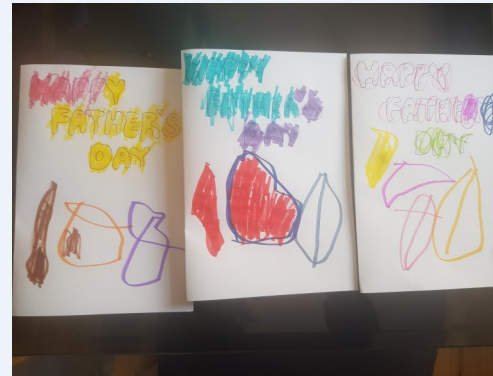
