## Woodthorne News Year 3, 29.6.20

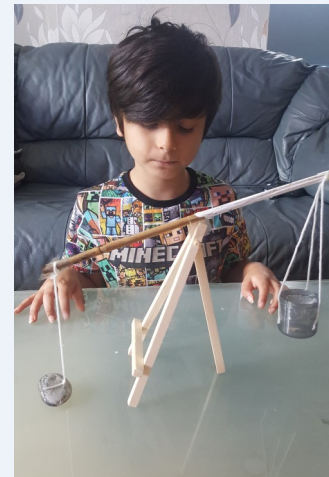

Good luck in year 4 from Miss Mahay, Mrs Weston and Miss Edwards.

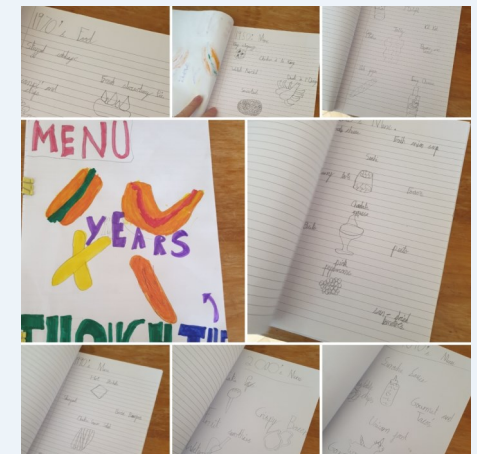
Here is a small selection of the photos you have sent in. It looks like the children have been having a fabulous time being creative!
