You may want to use a comma for more than 2 adjectives in a sentence, for example, The boy has a brown, white and yellow woolly hat.</p> <p>Tuesday – Describe the settings in the book, don't forget your adjectives. Think about the weather and temperature of the settings. Try to use a comma for more than 2 adjectives.</p> <p>Wednesday – Can you use a simile to describe the characters and the setting? For example, the penguin was dark as the night sky with a tummy like the snow glistening.</p>  <p>Thursday – Can you create a story map of the story?</p> <p>Friday – Rewrite the story of the 'Lost and Found' using all the work you have done this week. Include: adjectives, verbs, conjunctions, adverbs of time and include an explanation mark.</p> <p>Earn 2 house points.</p>	 <p>Describe the weather associated with each season including day lengths. Think about the seasons we have looked at.
