Use a paper plate or cut out a circle from card and design and collage you own paper plate face. What different materials can you use for the different parts of your face? With a grown up, you could talk about your different features and what



shapes they are.

With your grown up, think of 5 facts about you, you could have a go at writing them yourself or drawing pictures to represent them or ask a grown up to write them for you. This could be the colour of your eyes or favourite colour or any other interesting facts about you!

Hello, my name is Miss Cox, I am going to be one of the Reception teachers. I hope you all have a lovely summer and I look forward to meeting you all in September.

Write your name on a large piece of paper or card then use as many different things as you can to decorate it. Put glue on the lines and carefully add your decorations so we can still see your name. If you have a short name or you would like to, you could decorate



both names.

Choose 5 body parts and use a tape measure or an object to measure them with. Find out which is your longest and shortest body part.

You can practise talking about this. For example: my hand is 10 buttons long!
