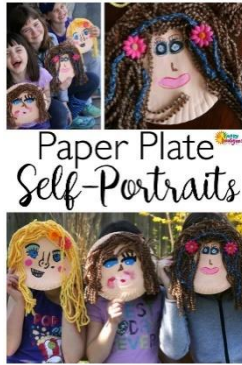
Living Things and their Habitats
