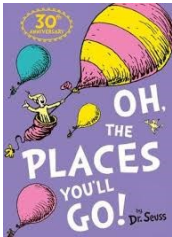
## Away We Go!

What are you looking forward to next year in Nursery? Is there anything you are worried about? Talk to your parents about September.

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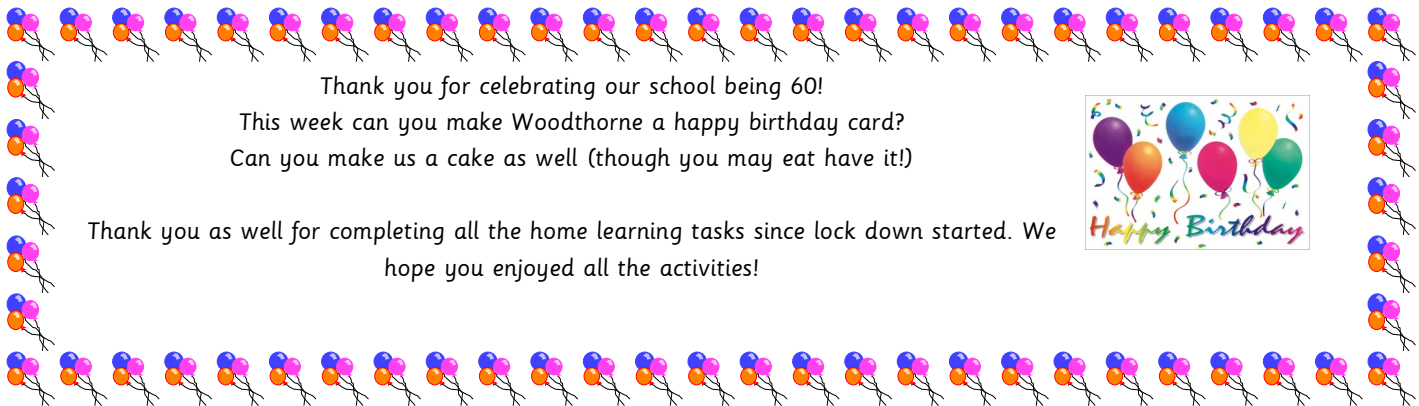
