In Reception children will learn to:

Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.

See themselves as a valuable individual.

Revise and refine the movement skills they have already acquired: such as rolling, crawling, walking, jumping, running, hopping, skipping and climbing

Read individual letters by saying the sounds for them.

Count objects, actions and sounds

Use all their senses in hand son exploration of natural materials and explore collections of materials with similar and/or different properties.

Explore, use and refine a variety of artistic effects to express their ideas and feelings.

At home:

Please share your child's book with them; you could talk about...

- The features of the book, title, author, illustrator, blurb
- What happened in the book
- If it is a story book or an information book
- What happened in the beginning, middle and end
- Whether you and your child liked the book or not and why.
