### Y4 Remote Learning

Dear parents/carers,

Further to yesterday's letter, we understand that you may find this current situation concerning but we assure you that we have worked closely with both the local authority and with Public Health England to ensure that guidelines have been followed. Our priority, as always, is ensuring the safety of our pupils and staff and we thank you for your support with this matter.

As you are aware, and as calculated by Public Health England, your child will need to isolate until Friday 30<sup>th</sup> October (during half term) and is due to return back to school on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> November. This week, we will be providing a mixture of live lessons, independent activities and other relevant tasks so that your child can continue their learning at home. If your child is absent from their learning on a particular day, you need to report their absence as usual via the school office.

#### Monday 19<sup>th</sup> October

- Your child will need to continue with the work pack that was sent home today (19<sup>th</sup> Oct) as well as completing the Purple Mash tasks that have been assigned for them.
- During the morning, a member of the Year 4 team will be contacting you and your child by phone. We appreciate that not all pupils have access to Microsoft Teams and if this is the case, please ensure you have informed school of this.
- Prior to live lessons commencing, you must have returned the home school agreement statement to Woodthorne's email account (sent today- 19<sup>th</sup> October). Please note, by agreeing to the statements outlined in the home school agreement, you are agreeing to your child being visible to and heard by their year group peers and school staff during live sessions.
- At 2pm today, children (who can access Teams) will be required to join their classmates for a short 'test' session to ensure that everything is up and running. The expectations and home school agreement will be discussed with your child.
