Year 2 Remote Learning

Dear parents/carers,

Further to yesterday's letter, we understand that you may find this current situation concerning but we assure you that we have worked closely with both the local authority and with Public Health England to ensure that guidelines have been followed. Our priority, as always, is ensuring the safety of our pupils and staff and we thank you for your support with this matter.

As you are aware, and as calculated by Public Health England, your child will need to isolate until Tuesday 1st December and is due to return back to school on Wednesday 2nd December. Week beginning 23rd November, we will be providing a mixture of live lessons, independent activities and other relevant tasks so that your child can continue their learning at home. If your child is absent from their learning on a particular day, you need to report their absence as usual via the school office.

Friday 20th November

- Your child will need to continue with the work uploaded onto Teams as well as completing the Purple Mash/ MyMaths tasks that have been assigned for them.
- During the day, a member of the Year 2 team will be contacting you and your child by phone. We appreciate that not all pupils have access to Microsoft Teams and if this is the case, please ensure you have informed school of this.
- Please return an email confirming that you agree to the home school agreement statement to Woodthorne's email account (sent with this letter) by Monday morning, before live lessons commence. Please note, by agreeing to the statements outlined in the home school agreement, you are agreeing to your child being visible to and heard by their year group peers and school staff during live sessions.
- At 2pm (Class 2A) and 2:30pm (Class 2S) today, children (who can access Teams) will be required to join their classmates for a short 'test' session to ensure that everything is up and running. The expectations and home school agreement will be discussed with your child.

I appreciate that this may be difficult to manage and we are looking for a solution to this.
