



Year 6 Residential Visit

Dear Parents/Carers,

Exciting news! We are now in a position to be able to book residential visits next academic year. This will be an opportunity for your child to create memories that they will treasure for life and will be a particularly special time following the last 18 months.

The residential visit will take place at **Plas Gwynant Outdoor Education Centre in Gwynant Valley, North Wales**, from **Monday 11th July 2022 - Friday 15th July 2022**. Children will be dropped off to school at 7:40am on Monday 11th July and should be ready to collect from school by 4:30pm on Friday 15th July. The exact times will be confirmed nearer the visit.

The cost of the visit will be **£410** for the 5 days. Included in this cost is the following:

- All food, accommodation and bedding
- All specialist equipment needed to take part
- All transport to, from and during the visit
- Launch to parents from Frank Chapman staff
- 24-hour pastoral care
- Full day and facilitated evening programme

In order to make the payments more manageable, there is an option on Parentpay to pay in instalments each month, beginning July 21' through until July 22'.

The payment schedule is as follows:

July- £25

August 21'- June 22' - £35 per month (11 x monthly instalments)

Total: £410.00

If your child is eligible for free school meals, please contact the office as we may be able to offer financial support to allow your child to attend.

Activities at Plas Gwynant are designed to help all pupils challenge themselves and exceed their own expectations. They require commitment, endeavour and resilience so that pupils leave with a feeling of success and a clear understanding that they are capable of achieving anything they set their minds to.

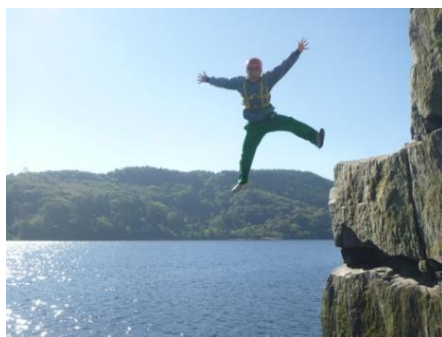


The residential programme will give your child the opportunity to:
