Year 2 Selly Manor visit
Wednesday 30th March 2022

Dear Parents & Carers,

16th February 2022

Next half term the children in Year 2 will be studying the Tudors as part of our History curriculum.

We have been fortunate enough to be able to book a visit to Selly Manor Museum in Bournville, Birmingham. This is a Tudor style house set out to demonstrate life in Tudor times. During the day, the children will be in their classes; one class will tour the house with a guide and experience typical Tudor life, food, clothing and jobs while the other class will gather in the education room to explore Tudor games and toys. After lunch, the classes will swap activities, so everyone experiences both aspects of the manor house. You may wish to visit the website at the following address:

The visit will take place on **Wednesday 30th March 2022** and children will need to wear full school uniform. They will also need a healthy snack, packed lunch and a bottle of water in a named carrier bag which can be thrown away at the end of lunchtime. As part of the Government free school meals initiative we are able to provide a basic packed lunch for your child, should you require us to. Please let the school office know if you would like us to provide a packed lunch for your child by 3pm on Friday ---March 2022. On the day of the visit we ask that children arrive to school at the **normal time of 8:40am** and are collected as usual, at 3:10pm

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £15.00 per child to cover the cost of the coach and entrance fee to Selly Manor. This can be made by using our online payment system ParentPay, where you we also ask that you give consent for your child to attend the visit. Please be aware that although the contribution is voluntary, if we do not receive sufficient funds to cover the cost of the visit it will unfortunately have to be cancelled.

Please do not send your child to school on this day if they are unwell or have any signs or symptoms of COVID. In the unfortunate circumstances, your child develops any sign of COVID or becomes unwell on the visit we will contact you to ask you to collect your child from Selly Manor.
