Dear Parents and Carers,

We can't quite believe it, but we're almost at the end of your child's final term at Woodthorne! Here are key dates for your diary that we have coming up:

Tuesday 28th June

A representative from Plas Gwyant will be hosting a meeting and Q&A session for parents at 5:30pm in the KSI hall.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, the School nurses have had to alter the Year 6 RSE lesson; it will now be delivered on Tuesday 28th June.

Tuesday 5th July and Wednesday 6th July

The Y6 end of year production will take place in the KS2 hall on Tuesday 5th July and Wednesday 6th July. We ask that the **children arrive at 5:30pm for a 6pm start**. Due to numbers, and in the interests of fairness, we will be limiting tickets to 2 tickets per child, per performance (so 4 tickets in total). The production will finish at approximately 7:30pm. Children **must** be collected - we will not authorise children to walk home without an adult at this time in the evening.

Tuesday 19th July

We are so excited to share that this year's Oscars Ceremony and Leavers' Prom will be held on **Tuesday 19th July**. We ask that the children arrive at **6:30pm for a 7pm start**.
