Year 2 Residential Visit

Dear Parents/Carers,

Exciting news!

We have now booked dates for our Residential visits this academic year. As every year group in KS2 had the option to go on a residential visit last year, we have now moved back to the alternate year group model: Y2, Y4 and Y6. This will be an opportunity for your child to create memories that they will treasure for life and experience whole new levels of independence!

The residential visit will take place at Edgmond Hall Centre for Outdoor Learning, from Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> May-Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2023. Children will be dropped off to school at normal time on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> May and should be ready to collect from school by 2:30pm on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May (the exact times will be confirmed nearer the visit).

The cost of the visit will be  $\pounds 184$  for the 3 days. Included in this cost is the following:

- All food, accommodation and bedding
- All specialist equipment needed to take part
- All transport to, from and during the visit
- Launch to parents from Edgmond Hall staff
- 24-hour pastoral care
- Full day and facilitated evening programme

In order to make the payments more manageable, there is an option on Parentpay to pay in 8 instalments-September' through until April 23'.

The payment schedule is as follows:

September 2022- £30 October 2022- April 2023- £22 per month (7 x monthly instalments)
