

Flu Vaccination 2022

Vaccination UK will be attending schools this Autumn and Winter to administer the annual flu vaccinations to primary school children.

You can complete your consent on line at <https://midlands.schoolvaccination.uk/flu/2022/wolverhampton> Consent must be given at least 48 hours before the flu vaccination is due to be given.

Delivering the vaccination programme through schools is the best way to ensure the maximum number of children are protected against flu. Vaccination will also help reduce the spread of flu and protect the whole population, including those who cannot or do not have the vaccine. With the flu season rapidly approaching, it will also help to reduce pressure on the NHS and other vital services.

The vaccine is also available to children aged 2 and 3, people with long term health conditions, the over 65s, carers and care staff, people in long stay residential care homes, pregnant women, those who live with people on the shielded list through their GP or pharmacist, while anyone else can get their vaccination from many local pharmacies for a small charge.
