Dear Parents & Carers,

We are very excited to write to you with details of an upcoming Year 3 visit on Wednesday 9th March. We will be travelling by coach to Bishop's Wood, Staffordshire. This trip will support our History unit 'Anglo-Saxons and Vikings'.

Children will view the longship which will give children a scale of a real Viking longship. We'll discuss battle strategies and learn all about Viking warriors! Children will visit a Saxon hall and forge area to help them reflect and discuss how the Anglo Saxon and Viking people lived. There will be fabulous opportunities to make clay pots, spin wool and make copper broaches- just like a real Anglo Saxon!

After lunch, children will take part in shelter building activities, learning how Saxons built their homes, fostering teamwork and communication skills.
