Year 5 are planning an exciting visit to **Blists Hill Victorian Town** near Telford on **Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023**. The aim of the visit is to enrich the children's learning in History about the Industrial Revolution and the Victorian era.

Blists Hill Victorian Town is an open-air museum that attempts to recreate the sights, sounds and smells of a Victorian Shropshire town from the 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries. In addition to exploring the village, the children will experience what it was like going to school in the Victorian era as they take part in a Victorian schoolhouse workshop.

We are asking for a voluntary donation of  $\pounds 23$  per child to cover the entrance fee, the workshop and the coach to and from the museum. This is payable via the school's online payment system ParentPay; where will also ask you to give your consent for your child to take part in the visit to the museum and access the playground whilst on the visit.
