



Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will know from previous correspondence, next week, is Year 2 SATs week. We would like to take this opportunity to inform you of the details for the week and reassure you we will do everything to ensure the children are supported in every way.

We will ensure the days next week run as close to their usual school day as possible, in conditions they are more than used to from the assessments they experience throughout the year. The papers will be referred to as work books and from our experience the children have previously not known that they are sitting these assessments and have quite enjoyed them. Pupils will sit 6 short assessments: Reading Paper 1, Reading Paper 2, Maths Reasoning, Maths Arithmetic and Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar. The assessments will be completed in small groups with a familiar adult.

Teachers submit their final teacher assessment in Reading, Writing, Maths and Science in June. The SAT results are a small part of making a final teacher assessment. The judgements made will be reported to you in the final school report this July.

Please do not feel you need to prepare your child in any way for next week, as they do not know they are taking part in 'tests'. However, it would be really helpful if you could ensure the following for your child:

- get plenty of sleep by going to bed at a reasonable time.
- eat a healthy breakfast to set them up for the day.
- attend school on time every day.
