Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 3 are planning an exciting visit to Weston Park with Educating Kids Outdoors (EKO) on Thursday 13th July. The children will know EKO as they provide outdoor learning on site here at Woodthorne. We are fortunate as this trip has received grant funding, so the cost has been greatly reduced. The aim of the visit is to enrich the children's learning in their science curriculum.

We are asking for a voluntary donation of £14 per child to cover the activities and the cost of a coach to get there. This is payable via the school's online payment System ParentPay; where will also ask you to give your consent for your child to take part in the visit. Please be aware that although this is a voluntary contribution, if we do not receive sufficient funds to cover the cost of the coach, we will unfortunately have to cancel the trip. All payments to be made by Thursday 29th June.

The children will need to arrive at school promptly at their normal time. We will travel to Weston on a coach and will return to school in time for the end of the normal school day. **You will need to ensure that your child wears outdoor clothing suitable for messy learning and wellies. Please dress for the weather and note that sunscreen and sun hat may also be needed.**

Your child will also need a packed lunch in a disposable bag and a water bottle on this day. Please do not pack any fizzy drinks, glass bottles or any nut products including Nutella.
