

## Good to be Green



If your child is green all day, you get a tick on the tally chart

Stay on green all week then receive a gold card, where pupils will receive a sticker on their chart.

If you are continually on green, you could get a gold or platinum card

Gold card – Sticker on your bookmark  
- Two house points

Platinum card - 5 house points (awarded by SLT)

- Sticker on your bookmark
- Name in hat for afternoon tea with the head teacher\

Once a bookmark is full:

- Receive a certificate in assembly
- Parents invited in for assembly
- Sent to phase leader for a dip in the box

## Good to be Green

Cards	Actions
Green	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A tally is put on the chart if a child ends the day on green</li> <li>• If a child stays on green all week then receive a gold card, where pupils will receive a sticker on their chart.</li> </ul>
Gold	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Given to children continually on green</li> <li>• If a child gets a gold card, a sticker is placed on their bookmark, two house points, note home via text or Class Dojo.</li> </ul>
Book marks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Once a bookmark is full, a certificate is presented in assembly and parents are invited in.</li> <li>• Children will be sent to phase leader to receive a dip in the box.</li> </ul>
Certificates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Give for complete book mark</li> </ul>
Platinum (Awarded by SLT)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sticker on bookmark</li> <li>• 5 house points/ raffle ticket for afternoon tea/ parents informed</li> </ul>
Yellow	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Miss part of break time (Teacher's discretion how long)</li> </ul>
Red	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Miss a lunchtime (or more with agreement of SLT)</li> <li>• Parent informed</li> </ul>
Class pass	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Class pass activities are discussed and agreed by the class</li> <li>• A display shows the class pass steps</li> <li>• Children who break class rules can miss class pass activity time.</li> </ul>
House points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children receive house points for receiving gold/platinum cards. House points can also be given for good effort</li> <li>• Certificates - per year               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Bronze – 25 house points</li> <li>○ Silver – 50 house points</li> <li>○ Gold – 100 house points</li> <li>○ Platinum – 200 house points</li> </ul> </li> <li>•</li> </ul>

Red and purple cards should be logged on CPOMS
